The Process

Classroom

Classes will be hosted with a Certified Drivers Ed Instructor. The class will run for 1 month and have an online final. Students will have a 30 minute lunch break and are encouraged to bring food.

- Students are allowed **1 absence**, but are required to make up the missed class.
- Make ups are completed by attending class the next time the lesson is offered.
- A student who misses 2 or more class days will be transferred to the next class.

DPS Appointment

Requires: Attendance to the first 6-hours of class & passing the Permit Test. Students will be supplied with the list of documents necessary for the DPS.

Appointment vs Walk-in: DPS offers appointments and limited same-day appointments.

DPS locations in Dallas-Fort Worth typically have availability 2-3 months in the future. Appointments can be scheduled at any DPS in Texas.

To schedule:

- Go to Public.TxDPSScheduler.com
- Select the service "Apply First Time DL/Permit"
- If this option is not available, Select "Service not listed or my license is not eligible" & select "No" for scheduling a Road Test. Students will not be eligible for the test at this time.

Scheduling Tips & Tricks: PLANNING AHEAD IS THE BEST STRATEGY

- Every location has different availability, so checking across different areas can yield sooner appointments. Students can go to ANY location in Texas.
- Recommended areas with sooner appointments include: Stephenville, Madisonville, Tolar, College Station & Houston.
- DPS locations in the Dallas-Fort Worth area are typically booked out 2-3 months.
- Some DPS locations are releasing same-day appointments on the scheduling website when they open in the morning. These appointments are limited and are taken quickly.

Driving

Requires: Learner Permit present for every lesson

- Includes 7 hours of driving & 7 hours of observation.

Students will book their appointments through their driving school account. Students can book 2 appointments at a time.

Cancellations & Rescheduling Policy: Appointments cancelled within 24-hours or if a student is absent, their account will incur a \$35 Fee. Appointments can be cancellations through the driving school account.

30 Hour Log: Students must complete 30 hours of practice with a licensed adult in addition to the 14-hours completed with the school. This log is available for download on Rules & Resources.

Contract Length

Students will have **One Year** from their first day of class to complete their classroom and driving hours.

If a student does not finish within their contract timeline, they may extend their contract. Extension Fees will apply.

Students who do not complete their teen drivers ed program will not be able to get a Texas License.

Age Requirements

Minimum age to start the class: 14 years old

- We recommend starting no sooner than a month before the teen's 15th birthday.

Minimum age to get a learner permit: 15 years old

Minimum age to take the road test: 16 years old

Learner Permit Expiration: 18 years old

- Expired Permits must be renewed to continue the program
- If a teen turns 18 prior to completing their remaining driving hours & road test, the learner permit must be renewed at the DPS office.
- Students cannot continue the program on an expired learner permit

Student receives learner permit after turning 18:

- 18 year olds do not have to hold the learner permits for 6 months
- These students can take their road test after completing their classroom and driving requirements

Verification of Enrollment

This document is required to get a learner permit. Students will request it from their High School. This document proves students have at least 90% attendance. If students are not eligible for a VOE, this will delay when they can start the driving phase of the program.

Tuition

A deposit of \$300 will reserve your student's spot in class. Final tuition payments are due on the last day of class. Late fees apply.

Road Testing, DPS & Getting a License

Requires:

- Students must hold the learner permit for 6 months
- Complete classroom and driving hours
- Be at least 16 years old
- Complete the Impact Texas Teen Drivers Program - Certificate Valid for 3 months

Students can include the DPS Road Test to their package when registering or add it at a later date.

A+ Academy Driving School offers the DPS Road Test, but is not authorized to issue a driver license.

After passing the road test, students will receive an envelope with their documents and test results. Once submitted to the DPS in person, teens will receive their Driver License.

When scheduling the DPS appointment, select the "Change, Replace, Renew" service for sooner appointments.
