Frequently Asked Questions

How it works:

This 16-day class will allow teens to get their Texas learner permit and prepare them with safe driving techniques before they begin their driving practice sessions. Students must attend the first 3 days to be eligible to take the permit test. Once students pass the permit test and receive their learner permit from the DPS, they can start practicing with an adult. Students will complete 7 driving sessions with the school and 30-hours of practice at home. Teens must hold the Texas learner permit for 6 months AND be at least 16 before they can test for their Texas Drivers License.

Can I make payments on the Teen Course?

A \$200 deposit will reserve their spot in class. All down payments are due before the first class day, however space is limited and classes fill quickly.

What if a student is absent to a class day?

Teens are allowed to miss a total of 5 class days. Missed lessons can be made up during the next course.

When can teens start driving?

Students can begin scheduling their 7 driving sessions after receiving a learner permit from the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) and tuition has been paid in full. The state requires teens to complete an additional 30 hours of driving practice outside of driving school. Log available for download in Rules & Resources tab of website.

How long does a teen have to complete the classroom and driving sessions?

Teens will have 6 months from the first class day to complete all classes, make ups and driving sessions. If a teen does not finish within the 6 months, they may be able to extend their contract. Extension Fees will Apply. Students who do not complete their teen drivers ed program will not be able to get a Texas Drivers License.
