Frequently Asked Questions

How it works:

Classroom: Zoom classes will be hosted with a Certified Drivers Ed Instructor. Students must be present for the first 3 days to be eligible to take the permit test. We will release DE-964 certificates during the second week of class. Pick up certificate at the location where student will complete driving appointments. The class will run Monday - Friday for 3 weeks and have an online final. Students must schedule an appointment with the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) to receive their learner permit.

Driving: The driving portion of the course will begin after receiving a learner permit. Students will book their appointments through their driving school account. Students must bring a learner permit & wear a face mask for all driving appointments.

Road Test: Students can sign up for the test when registering or can add it on at a later date. All students must hold the learner permit for 6 months, complete drivers ed & be at least 16 years old to be eligible to take the DPS Road Test for their license.

Can I make payments on the Teen Course?

For Zoom Class & Driving: A \$200 deposit will reserve their spot in class. All down payments are due before the first class day & final payments are due on last class day. If your package includes the Road Test, the balance will be paid with the downpayment. Late fees may apply.

What if a student is absent for a class day?

Students must complete 32-hours of classroom instruction. Missed lessons can be made up during the next course. If a student misses more than 5 class days, they will be transferred into the next course

What if a student is absent for a driving lesson?

If a student needs to cancel an appointment, they can cancel through their student account. If an appointment is cancelled with less than 24-hour notice or the student is absent, a \$35 Fee will be added to their account.

When can teens start driving?

Students can begin scheduling their driving sessions after receiving a learner permit from the DPS and when tuition has been paid in full. The state requires teens to complete an additional 30 hours of driving practice outside of driving school. The log is available for download in Rules & Resources tab of our website (<https://www.a-plus-academy-driving-school.com/rules-resources.phtml>). Practice sessions with an instructor will be scheduled through the student's driving school account.

How long does a teen have to complete the classroom and driving sessions?

Teens will have 6 months* (180 days) from the first class day to complete all classes, make ups and driving sessions. If a teen does not finish within the contract timeline, they may be able to extend their contract. Extension Fees will Apply. Students who do not complete their teen drivers ed program will not be able to get a Texas Drivers License. *Due to the DPS delays to get the learner permit, some impacted students may receive a courtesy extension.
